Expungement Package Passes Legislature, Signed by Governor: “Clean Slate”

[Bridge Magazine Article](#)

- ▶ The “Clean Slate” legislation requires the state to create an automated system over the next two years for expungements of certain felonies after 10 years and misdemeanors after seven years.
- ▶ Single crime expungement
- ▶ One provision takes effect in 180 days and allows those with marijuana misdemeanor convictions to apply for expungement if their offenses would have been legal for recreational use approved in 2018
